The Institute for Chemical Education announces the spring and summer schedule for the 1986 Chemistry Can Be Fun Program for Madison area students in grades 6, 7 and 8. This program, consisting of five sessions, is designed to acquaint the student with the wonders of chemistry using carefully selected demonstrations, lectures and laboratory experiments. Under the direct supervision of a staff of experienced chemistry teachers, each student will work in the laboratory learning safe ways to handle equipment and chemicals relating to the topic of the day. Each of these experiments is designed to teach in an interesting way a fundamental chemistry concept or technique. Many encourage the student to use his reasoning skills. The experiments include developing fingerprints from paper, making a latex rubber ball, growing crystals, converting copper into "gold" and identifying the contents of a mystery liquid.
